Overview

This week long class provides an in-depth look at the supports provided to individuals with Intellectual and developmental disabilities in WA State. We will provide training on Residential Services Guidelines, individual plans, behavior support, mandated reporting, and much more through the use of interactive learning and personal experiences.

The Residential Services Curriculum 40 Hour Core Training meets the requirements set forth in WAC 388-829, including the Personal Skills Acquisition and Support course.

*This class is also offered exclusively for Deaf staff – depending on the number of registered participants, PSRS will determine if a full deaf class is needed, or if Deaf participants will attend the class with interpreters.

Notes Class is from 9am – 5pm all days, with a 30-minute lunch break. Please arrive on time. Students must attend the entire week of classes to receive a certificate. Class includes Skills Lab. CE classes may be available based on class size - contact us for details.
